We have some very exciting news about our call for a new associate pastor!

On Sunday, July 23rd at a special congregational meeting, our congregation unanimously voted to extend a letter of call to Sarah Johanson to be the new Associate Pastor here at Good Shepherd. Our congregation is thrilled to have Sarah joining our ministry team, and our call committee, church council, and church staff can't wait for you all to meet her!

Sarah grew up in the north metro near Andover and attended Cross of Hope Lutheran in Ramsey. After graduating high school, Sarah attended Augsburg College in Minneapolis where she majored in religion and political science. Following college, Sarah attended Luther Seminary in St. Paul to get her Master of Divinity degree. Sarah is currently finishing up a chaplain residency at a local hospital and we're excited for her to join our ministry team in the fall.

Sarah is also a wonderful musician and lives in the metro area with her husband who works for the National Park Service.

This fall Sarah will share in the pastoral duties of preaching, teaching, worship leadership, visiting our members, working with the Church Council, and more. She will also be working closely with our youth - especially those in Confirmation and High School.

Financial Update

Our budgeted expenses at Good Shepherd for 2023 are \$521,651. Good Shepherd's budgeted expenses through the end of June was \$260,825.76 with actual expenses of \$246,861.65 or 94.65% of actual expenses.

Our budgeted income for 2023 is also \$521,651. Budgeted income through June was \$260,825.76. Actual income through May was \$172,228.47 (66.5% of budgeted income).

This gap between income and expenses is typical in summer months, and as always we're thankful for your faithful and regular giving which makes the ministry here at Good Shepherd possible.

**YOUTH MINISTRY – Becky Hall, Betsy Lindgren.** Our Christikon Bible Camp trip led by Ally went well and returned home safely. We had 20 students and three adult chaperones. A huge thanks to Ally Klug, Betsy Lindgren, and Renee Shaw for helping transport the kids to and from camp safely and for leading the trip along with the Christikon staff.. Our Houseboat Trip had several available slots and so we opened the trip up to those entering 9th grade. The trip is now full. Pastor Derek and Ally will lead this trip which departs July 31st - August 4th. We will have 30 students and 6 adult leaders.. Plans are underway for a President's Day Ski Trip for High School students in February of 2024. An interest survey will be sent out to families soon to lock-in our plans. We hope to begin promoting this trip with an official sign-up in September as the school year begins.
